The City of Ypsilanti City Council will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, September 15th, at the regular 7:00 p.m. meeting in the Council Chambers of the City Hall, One South Huron Street, Ypsilanti, Michigan 48197. The purpose of the hearing will be to receive public comments on the following:

Capital Improvements Program: FY2016-17 to FY2022-23

The City Council will hear a presentation, hold a public hearing, and consider the adoption of a proposed six-year Capital Improvements Program. A Capital Improvements Program is a strategic plan that outlines planned major expenditures in durable assets in the near future. This plan outlines the process for adopting and updating the plan, as well as a comprehensive list of currently-anticipated capital expenditures over the coming six years, broken into five budget categories (computers, facilities, equipment, motorpool, and infrastructure), classified by department, by anticipated year, and estimated cost to complete. A draft of the plan will be made available in the City Clerk's office of City Hall, and online at cityofypsilanti.com/CIP no later than noon on Monday, August 31st.
