SUBJECT: Residential Permit Parking Program – Ordinance to amend Residential Permit Parking Ordinance, Chapter 102, Division 3 of Ypsilanti City Code

SUMMARY & BACKGROUND:

It is requested that the City Council Agenda of December 20th include consideration of an ordinance to amend Chapter 102, Division 3 of the City Code, *Residential Permit Parking*. On June 21, 2005 Council passed Ordinance 1006, *Residential Permit Parking*, which allowed for various changes to the Residential Permit Parking Ordinance and program boundaries. Those changes did not address the necessity for non-resident property owners (landlords) to have access to their properties within the program boundaries. The proposed changes allow for landlords, their employees, and contractors access to their properties within the Residential Parking Program boundaries. Also included is a fee schedule resolution that reflects the addition of service, employee and contractor vehicle passes.
