SUBJECT: 2006 CMAQ Traffic Signal Project
DATE: March 7, 2006

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) along with the Federal Transportation Improvement Program has allocated funds to the City of Ypsilanti through the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Improvement Program for traffic signal upgrades on all signals within the city limits north of Michigan Avenue (16 signals), in the year 2006 construction season.

It is requested that the City Council approve the proposal submitted by Orchard, Hiltz and McCliment for design engineering, data collection, signal optimization and contract administration, in an amount not to exceed \$160,000. The total cost of construction, approximately \$650,000 is 100 percent federally funded. The project includes upgrades to all signals north of Michigan Ave. located within the city limits and optimization programming for all signals. The total estimated cost for this project is \$864,000.
