Dear Friends of Eastern Michigan University,

The Eastern Michigan University chapter of Habitat for Humanity would like to invite you to be a part of the project that is sweeping the campus. The Eagles Nest Project, a partnership of Eastern Michigan University (through the VISION office, the campus community service department) and Habitat for Humanity of Huron Valley, is a historic campus-wide effort to build a Habitat for Humanity home in the Ypsilanti community. This student-led initiative comes in two phases: phase one, which is taking place now, is the fundraising of at least \$65,000 through multiple activities of varying magnitudes, such as campus events, grant submissions, and community partnerships; phase two is the actual construction of the home, a feat expected to take place this fall.

Since the beginning of the fundraising campaign in September, the Eagles Nest Project has raised nearly \$11,000 through a collective effort by students, staff, and faculty, along with support from university administrators. However, in order to reach our fundraising goal of \$65,000 as soon as possible, thereby allowing the lengthy process of home construction to begin, we need your help!
