SUBJECT: 2006 CMAQ Bike Path Project

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) along with the Federal Transportation Improvement Program has allocated funds to the City of Ypsilanti through the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Improvement Program for the installation of a bike path on Huron River Drive from Forest to Lowell.

It is requested that the City Council approve the proposal submitted by Orchard, Hiltz and McCliment for design and construction engineering services in an amount not to exceed of \$42,000.00. The total cost of construction, approximately \$175,000.00 is 100 percent federally funded. This project will include the installation of a new asphalt path, all necessary traffic control devices. The total estimated cost for this project is \$217,000.00.
