Location: Meeting was held via Zoom due to the COVID 19 closure. It was recorded and hosted by the City of Ypsilanti Staff Bonnie Wessler.

1. **Call to Order** Commissioner Sweet called the meeting to order at 7:04 pm.
2. **Roll Call** Introductions of Commissioners Present were Evan Sweet, Cathy Thorburn, Ben Connor-Barrie, Dillion Navarre, Cherisa Allen, Kurt Kohlmann. Absent were Amanda Marshall and Julia Collins. Bonnie Wessler from the City was present
3. **Approval of Agenda**- Agenda was moved by Commissioner Connor-Barrie and seconded by Commissioner Kohlmann to approve the agenda. Roll call vote, Passed.
4. **Approval of the Minutes** –December 8, 2020 minutes. Commissioner Kohlmann and Commissioner Connor Barrie seconded approval. Roll call vote, Passed
5. **Introduction/Public Comment & Presentations** – Scout Zander Barr presented his plans for the Gaga Pit in Candy Cane Park. Commissioners will vote on his project after the final placement location is chosen.
6. **Old Business**
 - Ms. Wessler informed us that the DTE lighting has started and hopes to be completed this Friday in Frog Island.
7. **Friends Group Updates**
 - i. **Rutherford Pool** Commissioner Thorburn reported the final walk through last Friday. We are moving forward with planning for the Summer with contingency plans.
 - ii. **Senior Center**- Commissioner Sweet reported that mailings went out. Still looking for grants to help support the Center. No known opening time set.
8. **City of Ypsilanti Updates**- Bonnie Wessler reported that the City is still looking for grants for Frog Island improvements. The DNR stated that we do not have to update our Master Plan as it is all aligned with our present goals. The City is working with Washtenaw County Parks and Recreation and the Ralph Wilson Foundation to improve the paved trails in Riverside Park. No new trails will be added. Trails are an official part of the Border to Border trail. Looking to upgrade the storm water handling in Riverside park also.

b. Huron River Day The Huron Rivershed Council wants to broaded the park system exposure. No formal event but more of a 30 day challenge with things to complete or see.

c. Ypsi Fall River Day After discussions the Commissioners are concerned about what the event could look like or if we should hold it. Could there be a scaled down version? We will revisit it later.
