Chartered April 13, 1921, the Ypsilanti Kiwanis Club celebrates 100 years of service. Kiwanis remembers the work of Andy Smith and other Kiwanians who enhanced city parks and performed other projects that improved the lives of children making Ypsilanti a better place to live.

## Source & Installation

The boulder will be prepared to accept a plaque and will be provided and installed by the Rock Shop on North Territorial Road. The plaque will be a brass casting and will be provided and installed by Arnet's Monument of Ypsilanti/Ann Arbor.
