WHEREAS, The House of Representatives in the State of Michigan has passed House Resolution . 5479 that prohibits Cities and Police Departments from :Buying Back Guns from their citizens, and,

WHEREAS, the matter now rests with the State Senate for a vote, and,

WHEREAS, the Y-PAC considers that the Buy Back program is an effective measure in reducing gun violence, now.

THEREFORE . the Y-PAC urges the State Senate and our State Senator to vote against said resolution, and, further urge and direct the Mayor to communicate these sentiments top our State Senator, and,

FURTHER, that if such legislation is passed by the State Senate, Y-PAC urges that this resolution be communicated to the Office of the Governor of the State of Michigan wherein Y-PAC respectfully urges the Governor to veto the legislation.

The City of Ypsilanti Police Advisory Commission (Y-PAC) . hereby noted with sadness the passing of Police Lieutenant (Ret.) . Marilyn Moore.

Lieutenant . Moore joined the Ypsilanti Police Department on the first December 1973. On the 30th 1982 January she was promoted to Detective and on the 6th of July 1986 was advanced to the rank of Sergeant. Four years later Sergeant Moore was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant,

Lieutenant Moore retired from the Ypsilanti Police Department, after Twenty-Two (22) years of outstanding service on the 19th day of January 1994.

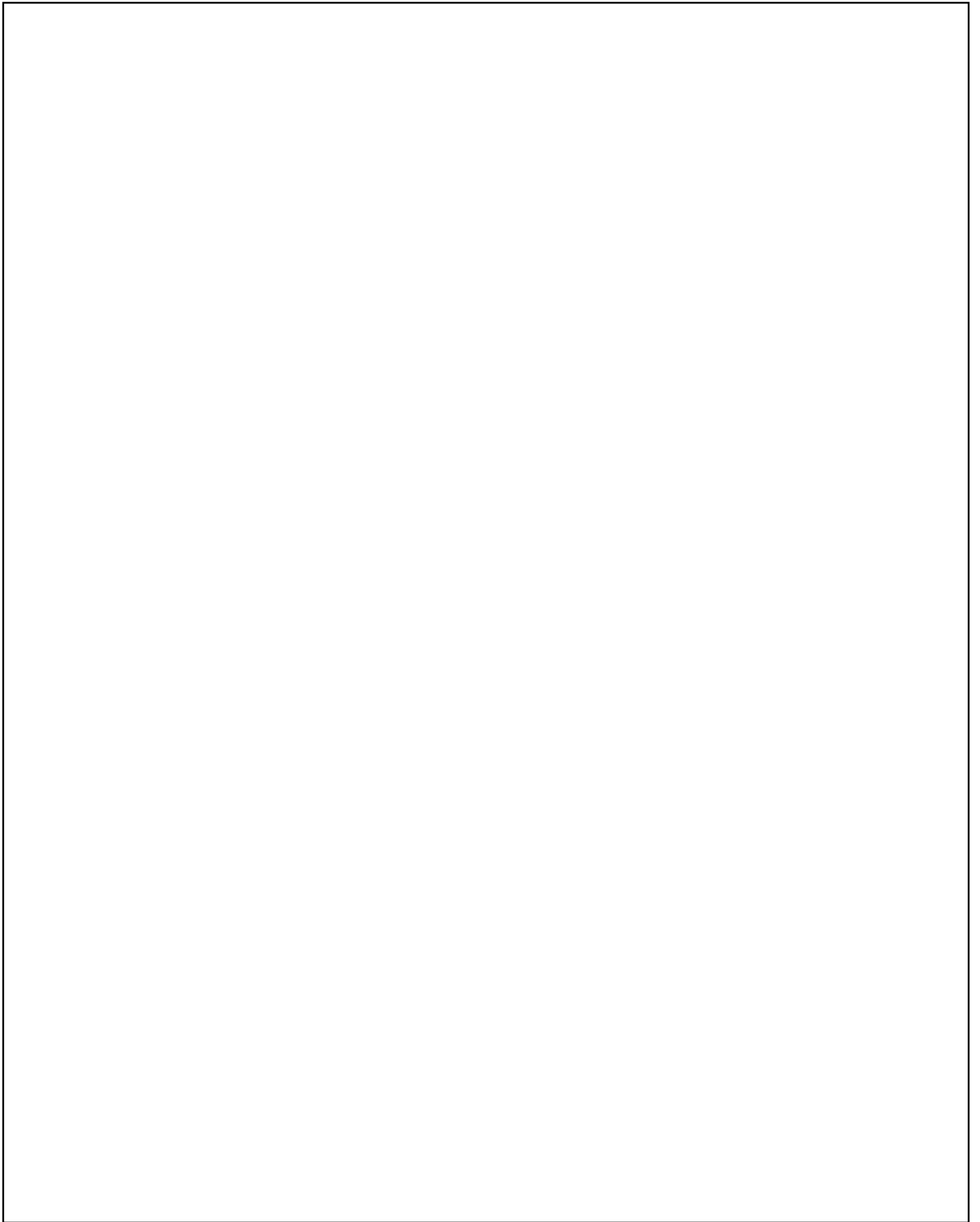
