Subject: Draft Sustainability Plan

The Sustainability Commission made the recommendation, at their September 14, 2020 meeting, that the Sustainability Plan be released for public comment. After the public review and comment period, the Sustainability Commission and City Council could potentially adopt the Plan.

Staff recommends incorporating the Sustainability Plan into the Master Plan by reference and inserting policy recommendations where applicable. The Master Plan update may be ready for Planning Commission's initial review by the November regular meeting. The sustainability text being inserted and referenced would be subject to change if the Sustainability Plan's text changes at all during the public review and comment period.

Tonight's meeting will give you the opportunity to ask the Sustainability Commission about any topics and themes that have been formulated through the sustainability planning process, and to provide any courtesy comments ahead of the public review and comment period. Discussion with the Sustainability Commission may be useful in guiding how the Master Plan be updated.
