CURRENT PROJECTS:

**Update on Hamilton Crossing Renovation (Parkview): Attached is the most recent progress report from Walter Norris, Executive Director.

E. Cross Project Update: Mr. Kirton reports that the water main connections at the Thompson Building have been installed, three cut-off valves have been installed on the water main and service change-outs have begun.

East and West Cross Streetscape Project: Mr. Kirton reports that bump-outs and ADA ramps have been installed on the north side with installation of bump-outs and ramps continuing on the south side.

Cross Street Project/ADA: Mr. Kirton reports that asphalt was milled-off on Monday, June 27th. Under-cutting of the sub-grade continued on Wednesday, June 29th and paving is scheduled for Thursday, June 30th.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

**Michigan Prisoner Re-entry Initiative Listing: Attached is the latest MPRI update from Chief Walker, as requested by Council.

Prospect Street Bridge: Council requested information on how long the proposed repairs would extend the life of the bridge. Mr. Kirton responded that it is estimated to be 5-10 years after the rehabilitation project takes place.

Street Cut on Huron River Drive (near McDonald's): Mr. Kirton researched this issue and found that the low spot on Huron River Drive belongs to MichCon and this has been repaired.

**Police Department: Annual Report from Chief Walker is attached

**Fire Department: Year-end report from Fire Chief Ichesco is attached.

Thompson Building: Chief Ichesco reports that masonry repairs began on Friday, June 24th on the south or Cross Street elevation. According to the Chief, the scope of the work is to close the ground level openings. Chief Ichesco met with the mason on this project on Tuesday, June 28 who stated that preparation will begin to complete the River Street façade. Interior walls are to be constructed sixteen feet in length beginning at the west wall or River Street side. A floor will be constructed and then an additional vertical wall constructed allowing for the second floor. When the floors and walls are completed, the façade work will begin on the River Street elevation.

Riverside Park: Mr. Kirton reports that the trees in the river at Riverside Park that were lodged against the gazebo piers have been removed.

Aerotropolis: We received an invoice from Aerotropolis in the amount of \$25,000 for our 2011 dues. Council may recall that in 2009, we paid \$5,000 and requested a hardship for the balance of \$20,000. Since the \$25,000 amount was not included in the FY 2011/12 budget, I have scheduled a presentation to be made by representatives from the Aerotropolis Development Corporation at the July 19th council meeting.

Grove Road Repairs - As you know, we were unsuccessful in securing a grant to repair the portion of this street from I-94 to the south city limits. Because we were unable to obtain this grant, our focus for the near term will be to continue to patch it. I have asked Mr. Kirton to consult with our engineers to determine if there may be a better alternative to cold patch. Township's officials have verbally offered to share in the cost of repairs, and depending upon the patching alternatives available, I may propose pursuing this option in more detail.

**List of Street Cuts: Pursuant to City Council's request, Mr. Kirton has prepared a list of city streets which have been cut and are to be repaired by YCUA or DTE/Michcon. Please contact Nan if you note other street cuts that are not on the list.

Depot Town Dumpsters: A letter was sent to the owners of the dumpsters in Frog Island Parking Lot (Aubrey's and Café Racer) as well as the dumpsters located on the right-of-way on Ninde Street (Sidetrack and Richard Reid). Two of the dumpsters in the City's right-of-way have been removed; Café Racer has indicated their lease runs out on the dumpster on June 30 and they will have their dumpster removed from the parking lot this week. Staff has been in contact with Bill and Sandee French and is working to set up a meeting regarding the remaining dumpster in the Frog Island and their options. We hope to have that meeting with them after the 4th of July holiday. The letter to Richard Reid, who currently lives in Florida, was mailed today, Thursday, June 30.

Ypsilanti Police Department: Chief Walker reports crime statistics for Robberies and Home Invasions indicate a decrease in these two crime offenses over previous years. Even with our reduced police force, this is attributed to the visibility and hard work of our road patrol officers, the DDA officer, and the support services of the Detective Bureau and LAWNET. Several of our local repeat offenders have been arrested for these types of offenses. Multiple suspects have been arrested for multiple robberies.

UPDATE ON HAMILTON CROSSING REDEVELOPMENT

JUNE 13, 2011

Progress on the redevelopment of Parkview continues. At the City Council meeting on June 7th, the Planned Unit Development, or PUD, was approved at its second reading. In addition, an emergency ordinance was passed which allows this zoning change to take effect immediately. The PUD is very important as it allows the property to be split into two parcels, as required by the separate financings of the two phases of redevelopment. Upon receipt of building permits from the City (in the approval process), construction on Phase II is ready to commence.

Phase II, which is the southernmost portion of the site, will be financed with low-income housing tax credits, a construction loan from Key Bank, a HUD Upfront grant and HOME funds from Washtenaw County. The loan documents for all of these pieces of financing are in final form. The property will be transferred to Revision Phase 2 Limited Partnership, the ownership structure required in order to flow the tax credits to the investor, a fund managed by Boston Financial (BF). A subsidiary of the YHC is the managing general partner of this partnership. The partnership agreement admitting the BF investor was executed on May 2, 2011, according to the required MSHDA timeline for the tax credits.

The property management firm, Millennia Housing, plans to have a leasing trailer onsite in August to begin marketing and leasing the units. It is anticipated that renovated units will be available to rent by fourth quarter 2011.

The debt financing for Phase I is a HUD 221d4 loan. The third party reports for that loan application are all underway (appraisal, plan and cost review and market study) and we have targeted July for submission of that application. As part of the Settlement Agreement between the Parkview Tenant's Association and HUD, HUD provided the YHC with 144 housing vouchers. The YHC is working with the Detroit HUD office to gain approval to project base 68 of these vouchers at the Phase 1 site. This is a critical component to support the debt on this Phase. Based on HUD's approval and closing timeline, we are pushing for a third quarter 2011 construction commencement for Phase I.

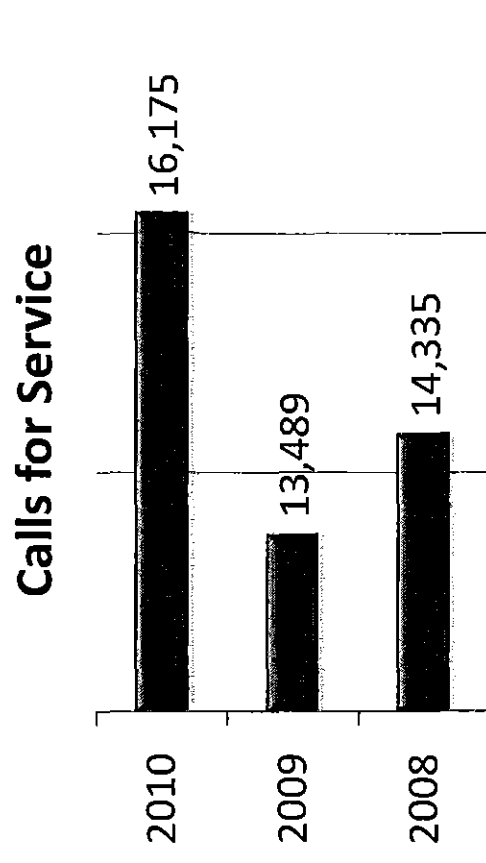

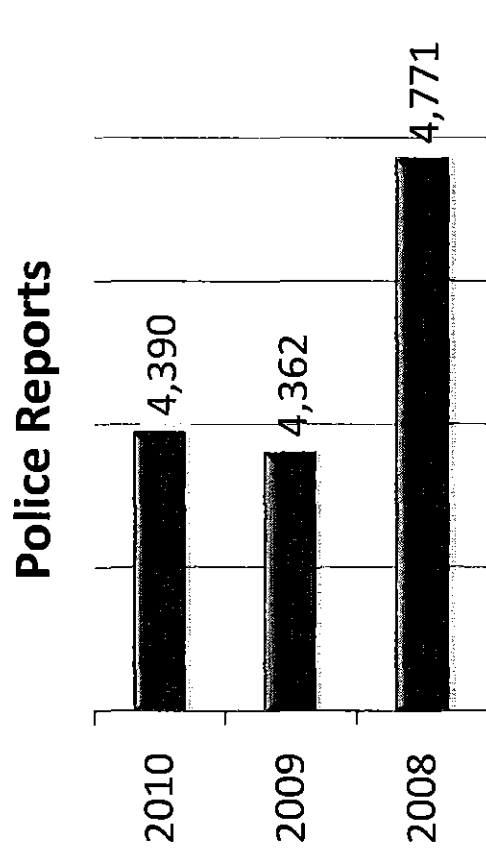

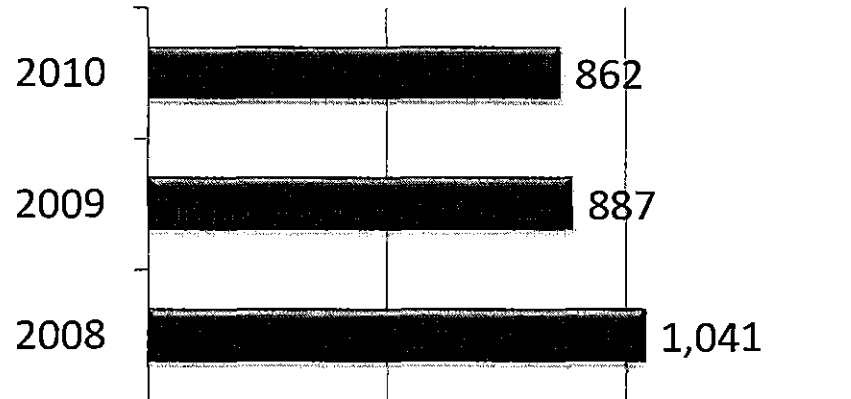

For reporting purposes, criminal offenses are divided into two major groups: Part I offenses and Part II offenses.

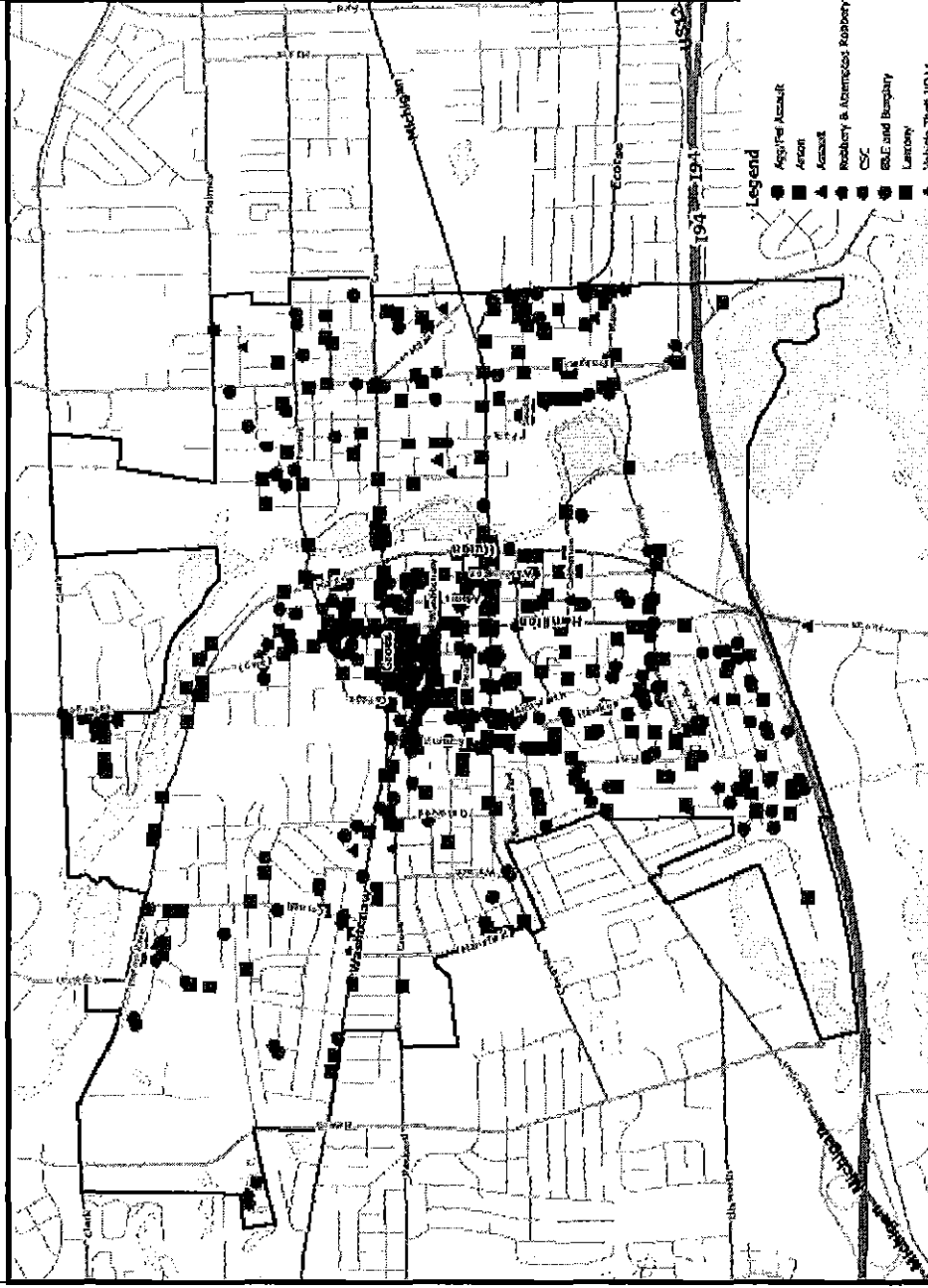
Part I Crimes

Part I Crimes, 2010



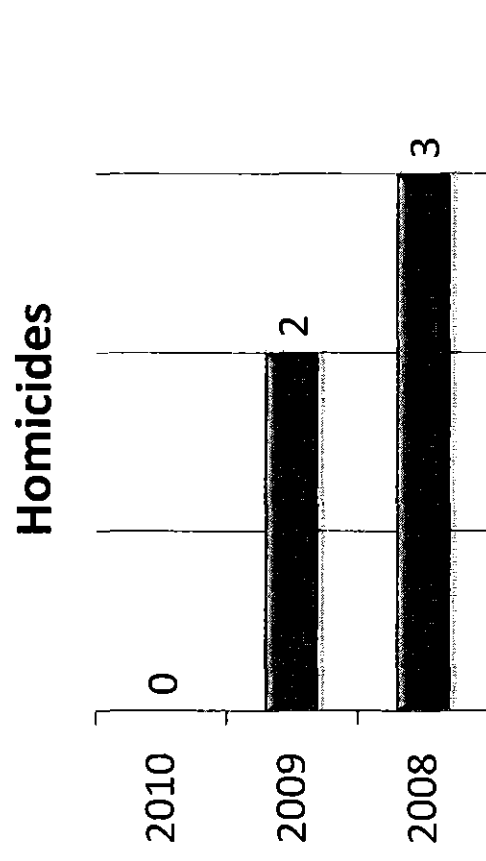
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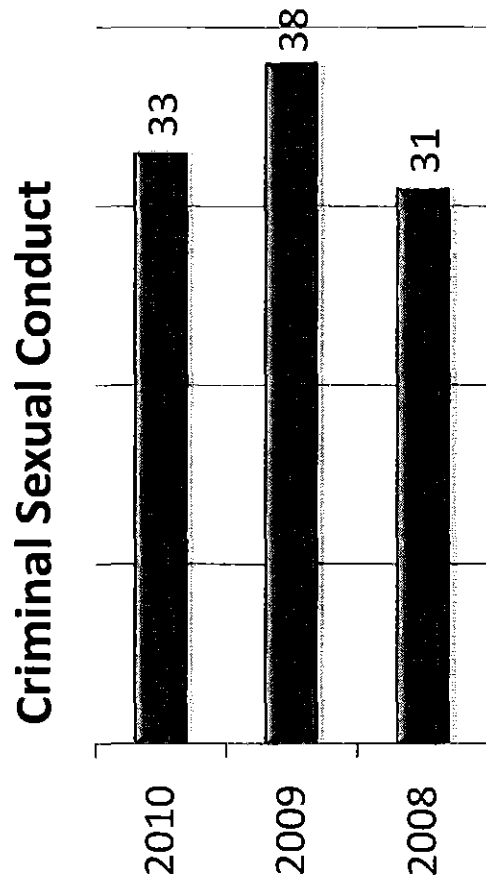

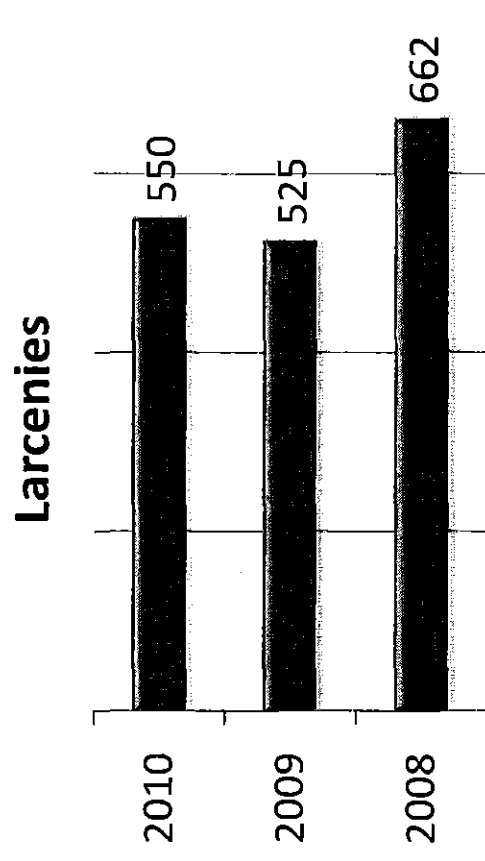
Damaged Property Crimes



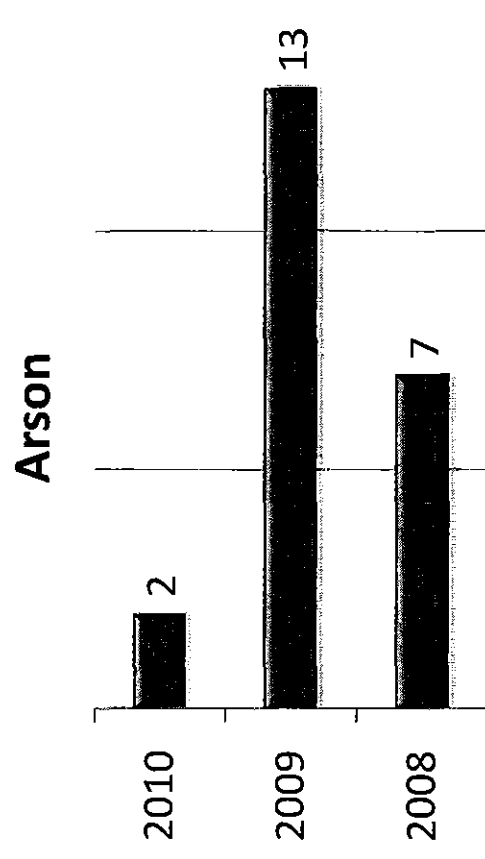

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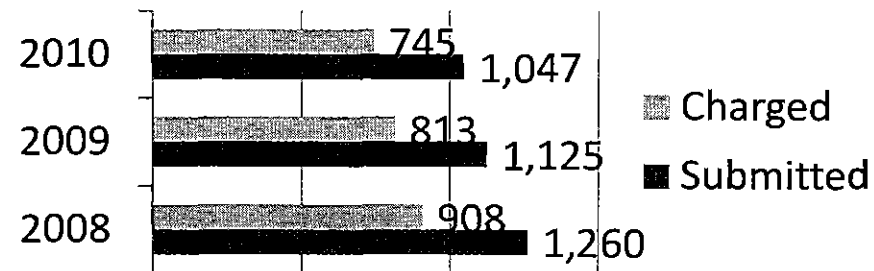


CLEARANCE RATES AS REPORTED BY STATE OF MICHIGAN

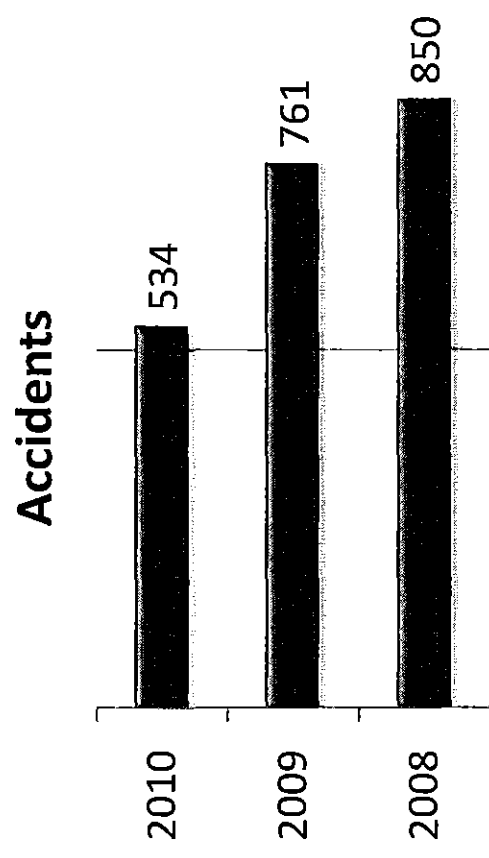

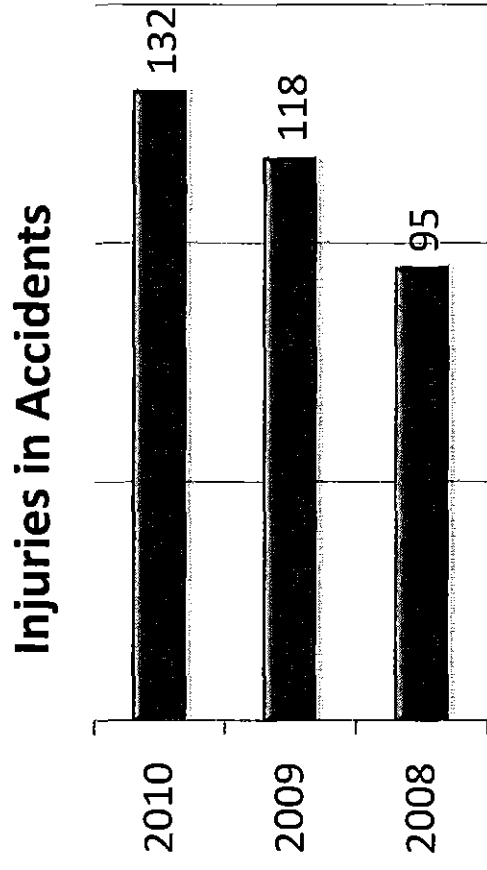
Warrants Submitted & Charged by Washtenaw County Prosecutor

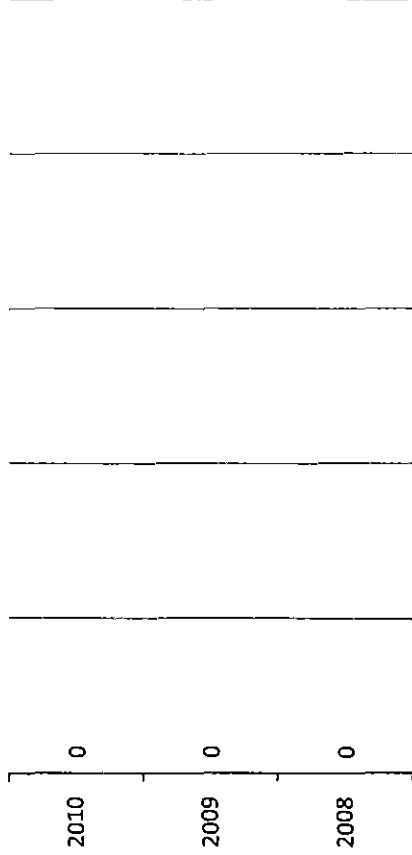

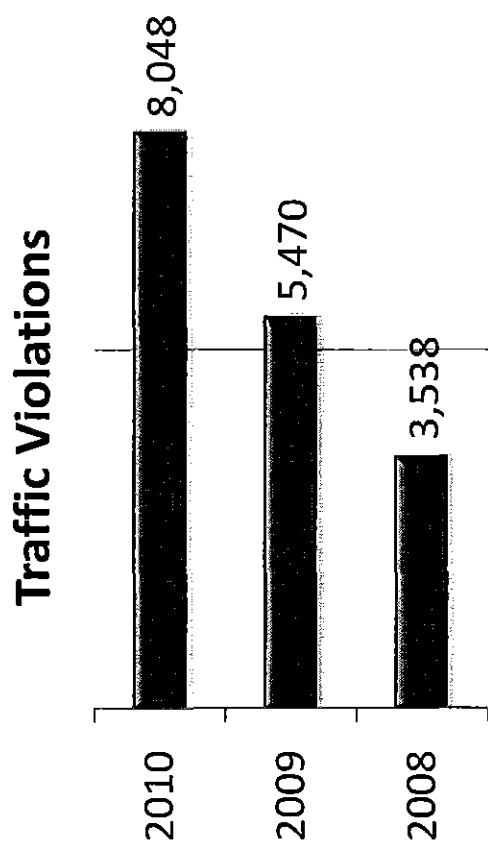

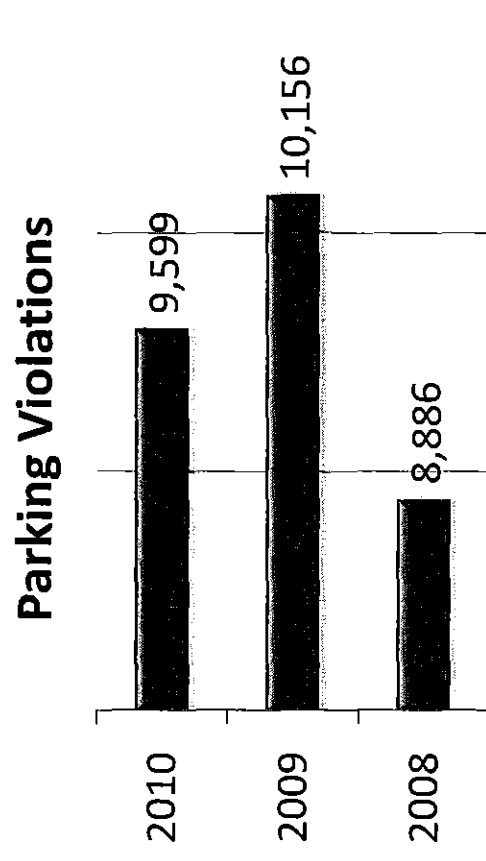
Fatal Accidents



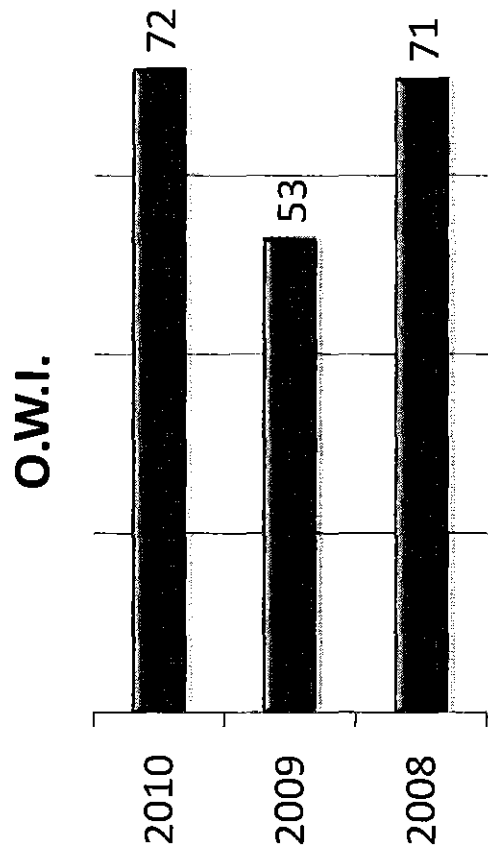

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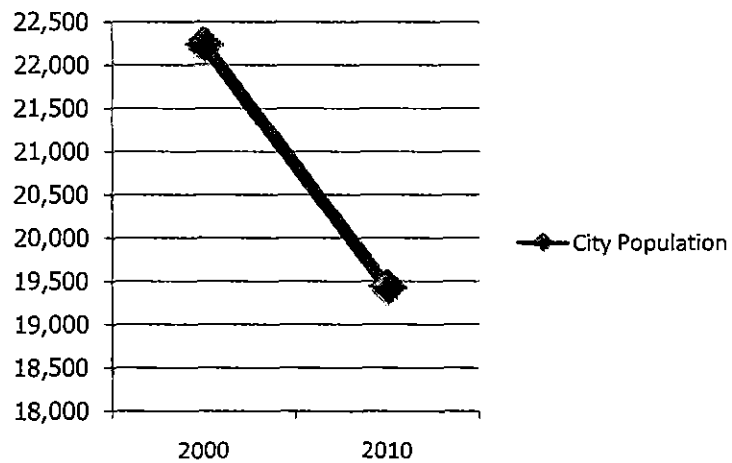

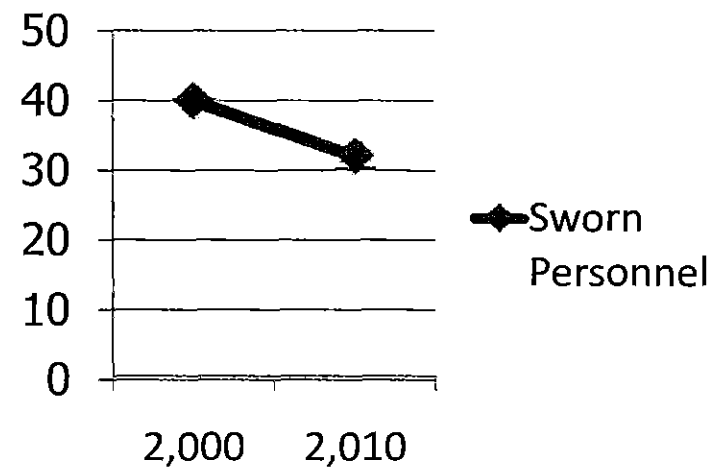


Population vs. Personnel

2010 FIRE SERVICES

YEAR END REPORT

Fire Services responded to 2133 emergencies for the 2010 calendar year. Of 2133 responses 1580 were EMS requests with the remaining 553 fire emergencies. The City experienced one serious fire loss August 20, 2010 at 158 South Prospect. An unattended frying pan caused the loss of three rental units with water damage to three others with damage estimates at \$200,000.

We experienced 86 actual fires.

Residential fires, 12 private dwellings, 23 rentals, and 3 not occupied accounted for 38 actual fires while commercial building fires, 5 public assemblies, 4 stores, and 1 not classified accounted for 10 additional building fires totaling 48 actual building fires. We responded to 9 vehicle fires, 13 dumpster fires, and 16 non-structural non-vehicle fires.

Ypsilanti is in the Midwest Region population group of 10,000 to 24,999 for comparison values. The average number of fires in comparable group is 3.5 per thousand we recorded 3.7 fires per thousand. Residential fire average 19, we recorded 38 residential fires. Total regional fire average 64 with 24 recorded as structural. Ypsilanti experienced 86 total fires and 48 structural. We continue to record incidents slightly above average which can be attributed to a higher number of rental properties than Cities with populations of our size. Ypsilanti is below the national average of 4 fires per thousand and well below the south region which is a 5.2 per thousand.

Rescues 102, false alarms 116, mutual aid 14, hazardous material responses 21, hazardous responses 67, and all other responses at 146 completed our response year.

Fire Services provided treatment for 1227 patients in the City of Ypsilanti, 68 on the campus of Eastern Michigan University, and 3 patients in Ypsilanti Township. Breathing complaints 319, chest pain 207, seizures 134, and persons down or unconscious 212 were the primary cause of requests for service.

Personal protective gear received inspection for use returned to service or repaired and returned to service. Gear found not serviceable or unable to be repaired will be parted out or discarded.

All building systems are being maintained in house at a general level.
