Contact them to schedule your pressure test. *** No completed pressure test means you will not pass your inspection*.**

Also, know that any flexible LP piping inside of the unit will be mandated to have either Dormont Blue or Regency brand mobile gas hoses. These hoses are tested to sub-freezing temperatures by the manufacturer.

Proper signage is another common violation. See the inspection sheets for further details.
